Coulson Aviation (USA) Inc. was founded in 1990 as a wholly owned subsidiary of Coulson Aircrane Ltd. From 1990 to 1993 Coulson Aviation (USA) provided the personnel for extensive heli-logging operations in Alaska. In the succeeding years, Coulson Aviation (USA) purchased its first C-130 Hercules that currently holds contracts within the United States and Australia. A second C-130 Hercules was acquired for the program in 2015 to accommodate the growing need for large air tankers.

Coulson Aviation (Australia) Pty Ltd was created in 2010 to support Coulson Aviation's long-term operations and commitment to its Australian customers. It was setup as a wholly owned subsidiary of Coulson Aircrane Ltd. to provide aircraft personnel for Coulson's rotary and fixed wing aircraft operating under contract in Australia for Firefighting and offshore oil applications.

Coulson Aircrane Ltd. (Port Alberni, BC) operate a Business and Quality Management System certified to ISO 9001:2015 + AS9100D for the manufacturing of parts and assemblies, including post-delivery support.



### WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR:

The Integrated Logistics Systems Specialist will be tasked to analyze, design, maintain and optimize logistic support of relevant equipment throughout its life-cycle of the HC-130 Retardant Delivery System (RDS) and other Coulson RDS.

This position is based in Port Alberni, BC Canada. Candidates must be eligible to work in Canada.

### **Duties**

- Prepare, coordinate, update, and manage logistics documents for acquisition milestone decisions and reviews.
- Coordinate the development and selection of logistics support alternatives for proposed system/component design.
- Participate in the preparation of a maintainability plan and conduct of maintainability demonstration, drawings, and engineering designs, and make recommendations concerning ease of maintenance of materiel.
- Ensure technical data is properly represented in manuals, procedures, and other ILS documentation. Manage subcontractor performing this function.
- Develop and provide input data to designers concerning proposed maintainability and reliability objectives.
- Support program planning and implementation to include developing maintenance plan, support and test equipment, technical data, training, logistic resource funds, supply support plans, and provisioning plans.
- Track and manage systems and repair parts supporting CONUS/OCONUS missions.
- Coordinate with other organizations for the planning, implementing, and support of systems.
- Participate on or chair logistics meetings with the government, such as the Provisioning Conference.
- Represent program in meetings and discussions with sub-contractors and government agencies.
- Review and furnish information to stakeholders (upon approval) concerning the support of equipment procured and utilized by the program offices.
