



Coulson Airplane Ltd. ("Coulson Aviation") is seeking an individual for placement to the position of Senior Pilot (Fixed Wing Operations). This is two year placement with responsibilities for flight Captain duties and operations management of Coulson Aviation's fixed wing fleet of Martin Mars aircraft and corporate Challenger 600.

The employee shall report to the Vice President, Aviation or to another supervisor as designated by the Company.

The position is based at the company facilities in Port Alberni and requires ability to travel and work in Canada and the United States.

The position is responsible for safe flight operations of the fixed wing fleet, including

- Challenger 600 Captain (FAA ATP license) duties on corporate missions;
- Martin Mars Captain (TC ATP license) duties on aerial fire-fighting missions;
- Challenger 600 Maintenance supervision (FAA A&P license);
- Piloting of other Coulson Aviation aircraft as assigned;
- Control of operations and operational standards of all Challenger aircraft operated by Coulson Aviation or its subsidiaries, including
 - Conducting all maintenance requirements;
 - Maintenance scheduling coordination, crew scheduling, load control, and equipment scheduling;
 - Supervision of and organization of:
 - i. Flight operations;
 - ii. Cabin safety;
 - iii. Crew scheduling and rostering;
 - iv. Training programs;
 - v. Flight Safety; and
 - vi. Maintenance review
- Liaison with the regulatory authorities, external agencies affecting operations;
- Liaison with maintenance support organizations (AMOs and OEMs)

Requirements:

- FAA ATP, SMELS, IFR, and CL600 type endorsement,
- TC ATP, SMELS, IFR, CL600 type endorsement, and Martin Mars endorsement (or hold FAA G-111 endorsement)
- FAA A&P or TC AME (M1 and M2)
- 5,000 TT, 1000 hours - medium jet aircraft PIC (CL600 or equivalent), 1000 hours heavy flying boat PIC (Mars or G-111), 1000 hours floatplane PIC
- 5 years' experience as an A&P or AME on jet engines, pressurized aircraft, large radial engines, and heavy flying-boats
- Experience working for FAA Part 91, and Part 145 operations, ability to hold Part 145 ACA authority
